Full time (32-40) hours are available with a typical work week being Monday through Friday 8 am – 4:30 pm. Will consider part time (24-30) hours, not all benefits listed will apply.

Must possess a current Ohio RN license and be in good standing with the State of Ohio pursuant to section 4723.13 of the Ohio Revised Code.
